The test as well as the overall outcome itself represent a prerequisite for the enrolment in the Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society.</p>
	<p><i>Evaluation criteria for the tests</i></p> <p>Students demonstrating to be in possession of the required basic knowledge in the relevant subjects during their interview are admitted to the Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society. Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society can be accessed without any numerical limitation.</p>

Successful candidates will be allowed to enrol in the degree course. Failure in the assessment test will result in the Candidate not being allowed to enrol.
