Admission requirements:

Assessment methods of student's initial preparation:

Oral interview

The verification of the adequacy of a student's preparation is carried out by means of individual interviews aimed at assessing the basic level of knowledge as specified below. The test as well as the overall outcome itself represent a prerequisite for the enrollment in the Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society.

Evaluation criteria for the tests

Students demonstrating to be in possession of the required basic knowledge in the relevant subjects during their interview are admitted to the Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society. Level 2 Degree Course in European Heritage, Digital Media and Information Society can be accessed without any numerical limitation.

The assessment will consist of an oral test in front of a Commission appointed for this purpose by the Faculty and composed of 3 teachers, who verify thecandidate's knowledge in the relevant areas of study.

Successful candidates will be allowed to enroll in the degree course.

Failure in the assessment test will result in the Candidate not being allowed to enrol. The tests will be in each case preceded by the verification of the requirements as specified above.

Results will be published in accordance with art. 8 of Law 241/90. No direct communication will be send to the candidate.
